● June 11 is Camp Day at Tim Hortons, which will be donating proceeds from its coffee sales to send thousands of kids to camp.

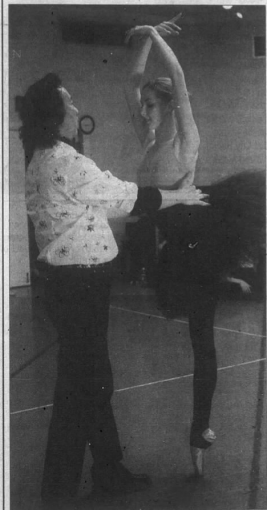
